

Rural America's Economy Can Grow by Rebuilding Food Supply Chains




American agriculture is diminishing as a net export sector. Food and fiber imports have surged more than exports during the free trade agreement era.






The cattle supply chain is the biggest sector in agriculture. Our trade deficit with free trade agreement countries in cattle and beef is worsening.
